

Environmental Stewardship in the Orthopaedic Operating Room

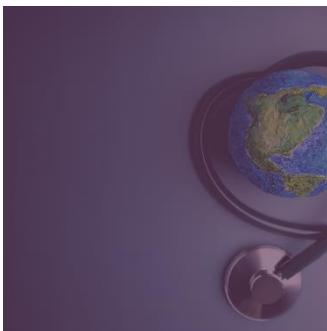
